“Hello, Anna and Ben!” Frosty said.



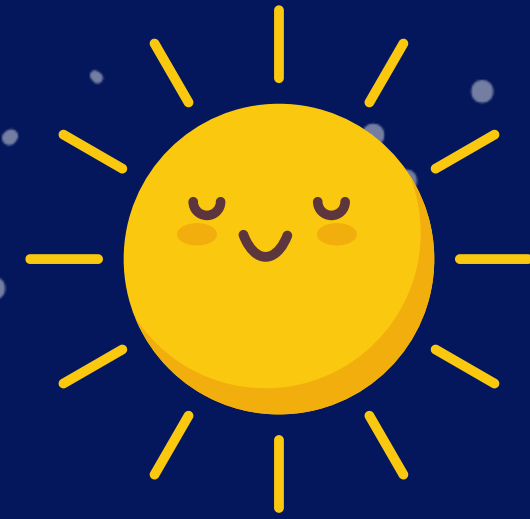
Anna and Ben were so surprised.
